Targeted beneficiaries	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - The most exposed and unprotected group are children but not only, their families as well, from Roma and non Roma; - The second target group are children and poor families Roma and non Roma, their parent’s women and men head families without income; - The third target group are the professionals of state structures from social services, CPUs, schools, health institutions, police, grassroots and other partners working that are operating in the area.
Main activities	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Street Law Activities; • Offering free legal aid for 200 beneficiaries in the targeted areas, through court and administrative procedures; • Organize three trainings for representatives of state social service, CPUs, health and education institutions, police etc. in the field of legal aid and social service provision; • Creating a dedicated section in TLAS portal for the social programmes in TLAS portal, through the usage of innovative IT tools.



Project results

1. Increase community and LAN knowledge on the possible social programmes that are provided by state structures and not only, in the country;
2. Higher access to social services by ensuring free legal services for 200 direct beneficiaries;
3. Enhanced capacities of grassroots and community based organizations on the development and solving of individual cases, without needing to refer everything to TLAS;
4. Innovative tools which will contain easily accessible information by any interested person on social services.
