MamiCare is a fitness, educational and community center for new parents. New and expectant mothers will meet others like themselves and can take prenatal and post-partum classes from experts in pregnancy, post-partum care and infant development

Main results of the action:

- Establishment of the first prenatal gym in Albania enabling expectant and new families to learn how to have a healthy pregnancy and birth; discover how to navigate into parenthood and network with other families;
- Provision of free of charge services for disadvantaged young mothers and families;
- At least 20 new parents informed and prepared on parenting.
